Our Snack Policy:

Please provide 2 snacks (each including 2 food groups) in your child's lunch box If they are here all day.

If you attend half day, please provide 1 snack. Label snacks with name and continue to follow our healthy food guidelines.

Outside Recess:

We **ALWAYS** go outside for recess, so please send your child to school with weather-appropriate clothes, if we ever get winter weather! (warm coat, a hat, and mittens, snow boots if needed). It is very helpful to **label each individual item** with your child's name. All items left at cubby area will be put in our lost and found box at the end of each day. Please look there to find any missing clothing items. Also, at home help your child identify their things so they can find them independently.

Emergency Contacts:

We will be updating our student files in January and would like all blue cards to be current by then.

We are required by law to be able to reach you at any time

while your child is in our care. We would like to avoid any problems reaching parents due to old phone numbers or blue card emergency contacts that are no longer available. We must be able to contact you at **ALL** times while your child is in our care. Example: You have a special appointment, are going shopping, taking a class, etc...it is very important that we have this information so we can properly take care of your child or give us another contact for that day. Thank you!

Parking Lot Safety: When coming into or walking out of the school, please be sure your child stays near you the entire time. It can be a busy place (especially at drop off and pick up) and it is extremely hard for other drivers to see small children.

Also, please turn off your vehicle once you have parked. We don't want our students breathing in gas fumes. Yuck!!

Tuition Increase:

I'm sure everyone knows that Flagstaff's minimum wage increase to \$18.35 takes effect January 1, 2026. That means we will be increasing our tuition in February 1, 2026. The new tuition rates are attached to this e-mail. If you have any questions, please talk

with Beth. We suggest you attend a city council meeting or write a letter about how you feel about the wage increase and how it is affecting families' budgets for goods and services. FYI: There is no end in sight, which is not going to help any of us! Also, tipped employees will be making the same wage, something that you should know when you patronize a restaurant in city limits.

Snow days:

If it ever gets cold enough to snow... We will be closed due to weather/snow conditions if FUSD is closed. If they are on a delayed schedule, we will be open at our normal time (7:30 am). Listen to local radio and TV or check the FUSD website, www.fusd1.org, for school closures due to snow. We will post closures as soon as we know on Facebook and Instagram as well.

Tuition Payment Policy:

Tuition is due by the 5th of each month, unless other arrangements are made with Beth or Kori. Payment after the 10th will result in a \$30.00 late fee. If no payment is received by the 15th your child will not be able to attend school until your tuition is received.
